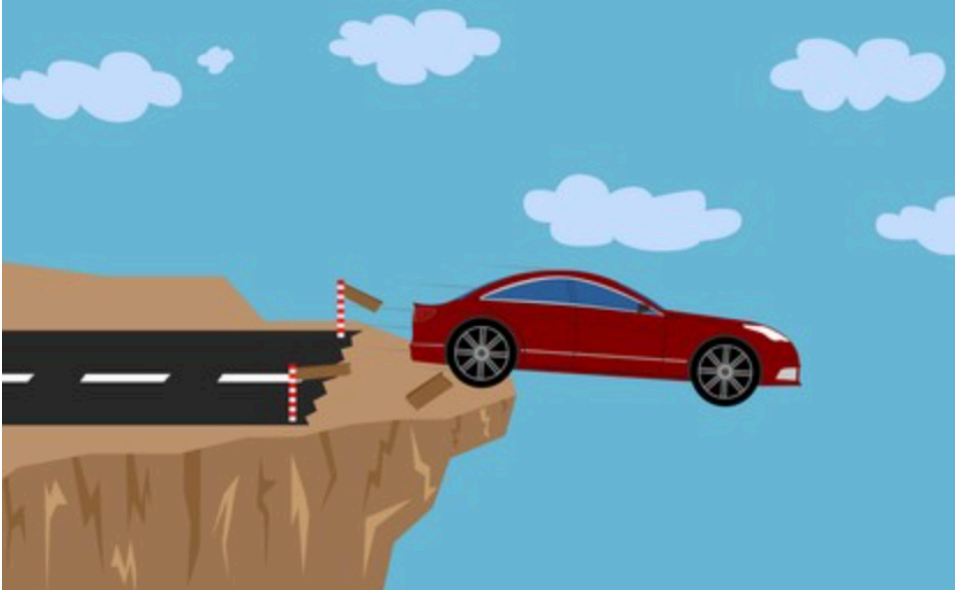


Is the Daily Mail **unsustainable**?

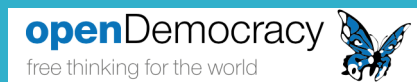
